1: Sergeant Fryt presented a proposal to implement a cadet program at Blackman-Leoni Department of Public Safety. This program/proposal was put together by Sergeant Fryt and Sergeant Gillespie and is designed to combat recruitment issues and mold PSO Candidates. Stryker has now released a newer Lifepak (CR2) that is cheaper and practical for our use than the Lifepak 1000. Additionally, for a limited time, Stryker is accepting \$250.00 credit for old outdated LifePak trade-ins. Public Safety will trade in 2 Lifepaks that are outdated and out of service, giving us a \$500.00 credit. Scott Pack made a motion to authorize the Director of Public Safety to purchase 2, LifePak CR2 Defibrillators from Stryker Industries for \$4,030.42. This motion was supported by Mike Thomas.
